Election Commission Members verified the Early Voting Machines and signed the certification documents.

Chairman Ehmling suspended the meeting at $4:17~\rm p.m.$ and reconvened the meeting in the Chambers at $4:20~\rm p.m.$

Motion by Commissioner Fussell and seconded by Commissioner Collins to insert item B after item C and the motion passed 4-0.

B. UPDATE ON ABSENTEE & ONLINE VOTER REGISTRATION

Election Deputy Gay Sutley reported the increased numbers of Absentee Applications and OVR Applications. Significant increase.

E. INSPECTION - APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Three appeals were presented individually by Election Deputy Sutley with all appropriate paperwork whereby the voter inadvertently marked and signed their application that they were felons. Each appeal was reviewed by the Commissioners. The first appeal was accepted and the voter registration application was accepted with a motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Fussell and the motion passed 4-0. The second appeal was accepted and the voter registration application was accepted with a motion by Commissioner Fussell and seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 4-0. The third appeal was accepted with a motion by Commissioner Fussell and seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 4-0.

D. INSPECTION - NEW PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

The Election Commissioners reviewed 336 New Registrations out of 3355 total new voter registration applications with no discrepancies noted and signed the inspection form to submit to the State Election office.
