

**SUMNER COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES THURSDAY,
MARCH 14, 2024, 4:00 P.M.**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling; Secretary Denise D. Shepherd; Commissioners Patricia D. Collins, J. Michael Fussell and Jeffery B. Hulsey. Also present: Lori D. Atchley, Administrator of Elections (AOE) and Annette Haw, Assistant Administrator of Elections (AAOE).

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairman Ehmling with a motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5 – 0. A quorum was present.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

Commissioner Fussell made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5 – 0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS

No one signed up for public comments.

IV. APPROVE MINUTES

A motion by Commissioner Fussell and seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to approve the: **FEBRUARY 28, 2024, SPECIAL CALL MEETING MINUTES** and the motion passed 5 – 0.

V. NEW BUSINESS A. INSPECTION – APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

None.

B. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Commissioners inspected 44 voter registration applications out of 438 new registration applications with no discrepancies noted. Commissioners present signed the report to be submitted to the State Division of Elections.

C. REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATOR - FACILITY UPDATE

AOE advised the SCEC continues to operate in two separate locations. The County Commission, via their attorney Ross Pepper, appealed Chancery Judge Oliver's prior ruling. Judge Oliver ruled that the county commission did have the right to decide space occupation, but following, the County Mayor would have oversight of the day-to-day operations. The Judge enjoined the SCC from interfering with the SCEC in conducting elections, to include not requiring the SCEC to move from the building at 1019 Union School Rd.

- BUDGET UPDATE

The SCEC continues to operate on last year's budget, which AOE had advised the SCEC immediately upon County Commission approval, would not be

sufficient. AOE was notified initially upon submittal of poll worker payroll payment that the Finance Department would not pay the poll workers for the March 5, 2024 Presidential Preference Primary. Upon advisement by AOE to the Finance Director and Law Director, and reference to TCA 2-11-202 (a)(5), the poll worker payroll was then immediately approved.

- CERTIFY MARCH 5, 2024 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY, COUNTY PRIMARY AND HENDERSONVILLE REFERENDUM ELECTION.

AOE read aloud election results. Motion by Commissioner Fussell to certify the election results as reported by AOE, seconded by Commissioner Shepherd and the motion passed 5 – 0. The Election Summary Report is attached.

- OTHER

AAOE notified the SCEC of upcoming Election Commission Meeting dates.

No Report.


B. ELECTION COMMISSIONERS




