

**SUMNER COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES
MAY 17, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling; Secretary Patricia D. Collins; Commissioner J. Michael Fussell; Commissioner Jeffery B. Hulsey; and Commissioner Denise D. Shepherd. Also present: Lori D. Atchley, Administrator of Elections and Annette P. Haw, Assistant Administrator of Elections.

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m. by Chairman Ehmling with a motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins, and the motion passed 5 - 0.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

The agenda was approved with a motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey, and the motion passed 5 - 0.

III. OLD BUSINESS

A. APPROVE MINUTES

Commissioner Shepherd made a motion to approve the April 14, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes, seconded by Commissioner Fussell and the motion passed 5 - 0.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

A. INSPECTION – APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

There was one appeal presented to the Election Commission. The applicant (MS) registering to vote checked “yes” to the “have you been convicted of a felony?” question. An appeal form was sent to the applicant who returned the form as having inadvertently checked “Yes” to the “Have you been convicted of a felony?” All Commissioners present reviewed the documentation presented. Motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins, to allow the applicant to properly register to vote and the motion passed 5 – 0.

B. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Commissioners inspected 66 voter registration applications out of 658 new registration applications submitted with no discrepancies noted, and all Commissioners present signed the report to be submitted to the State Election Office.

C. REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATOR

- MAY 3, 2022 ELECTION CERTIFICATION

AOE and AAOE read the Election Results from the May 3, 2022 State Judicial Primary and Sumner County Primary.

- Motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Fussell to certify the Republican Primary and the motion passed 5 – 0.
- Motion by Commissioner Shepherd, seconded by Commissioner Collins to certify the Democratic Primary and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- APPROVE AUGUST 4, 2022 POLL WORKERS

AAOE presented a list of poll workers for the August 4, 2022 election to each of the Commissioners for review. Commissioner Hulsey made a motion to approve the poll workers as presented with the caveat that AOE and AAOE could fill vacancies as appropriate to properly staff the polling locations on Election Day, seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- VVPAT LEGISLATION

AOE stated that VVPAT (Voter Verified Paper Audit Trail) legislation had passed the legislature via House Bill 1777/Senate Bill 1929. The legislation required a paper audit trail mechanism, as approved by the State Election Commission, to be in place by January 1, 2024. AOE state that the Sumner County Budget Committee had already appropriated the funds to secure new voting machines that contained the VVPAT in anticipation of the legislation. AOE stated that an RFP would be prepared for the bid process for the new equipment as soon as possible. The Sumner County current Vendor, Microvote, indicated that the lead time for new equipment was 6 to 9 months due to worldwide supply chain issues. AOE stated that

assuming the new equipment was timely received, it would be utilized for the 2024 election cycle.

- **CONVENIENT VOTE CENTERS**

AOE stated that convenient vote centers had been approved for use in Sumner County by the State Election Commission and State Legislature for the 2022 election cycle, along with three other Tennessee Counties. Due to COVID, Federal census data was significantly delayed which delayed Sumner County redistricting. AOE stated that none of the counties named were able to implement Convenient Vote Centers due to the date of completion of redistricting in relation to the May, 2022 election. AOE stated that with the new equipment purchase, CVC's could be implemented for the 2024 Election Cycle. Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Hulseley to pursue implementation of CVCs for the 2024 Election Cycle, and the motion passed 5 – 0.

- **OTHER**

- AOE stated that the next Election Commission meeting was June 14, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. The August ballot bags would be locked at that time.
- May 3, 2022 participation for Sumner County voters was 14.07%. AOE recommended reduction of Early Voting sites to one full time site in Gallatin and Satellite Voting in each of the municipalities. After general discussion, motion by Commissioner Hulseley, seconded by Commissioner Shepherd to hold Early Voting full time during the Early Voting period in Gallatin (Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.), six days in Hendersonville (Monday thru Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.) on the dates of July 18 thru July 23 and hold one day of Satellite Voting for each additional municipality to include White House, Portland, Westmoreland and Goodlettsville (10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.). The motion passed 5 – 0.
- AOE stated that the Early and Election Day site rules that had been challenging - as candidates often violated many rules, specifically involving signage (size and number), as well as campaign boundary infractions and interfering with voters attempting to enter the polling location for the purpose of casting their vote. After general discussion, Chairman Ehmling stated that the rules would remain in place for the Public Safety of


Candidates, Candidate Workers, Poll Workers and Voters, as well as non-interference of voters attempting to enter the polling location for the purpose of casting their vote. The rules would be distributed to each campaign along with a request to follow the rules as set forth equally for all candidates.

V. REPORT FROM ELECTION COMMISSIONERS


- A. Chairman reported visiting multiple precincts.

VI. ADJOURNMENT


