INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

Voting Machine:

Place an "X" by pushing the gray button next to the Candidate's name for whom you wish to vote.

When finished, press the red "CONFIRM" button. Review the printed paper summary of candidates you have selected.

Once satisfied with all candidate selections, Press the "CAST VOTE" button.

NOTE: Once the "CAST VOTE" button is pushed, there is **NOTHING** that can be done to make changes to your selections.

Paper Ballot:

(For Absentee or Provisional Voting Only)
Fill in the numbered circle next to the Candidate's name for whom you wish to vote.

Complete the ballot envelope flap and sign.

Place the ballot in the envelope provided, seal and mail if an Absentee Ballot.

If during Early Voting or on Election Day, place the ballot in the locked ballot bag.

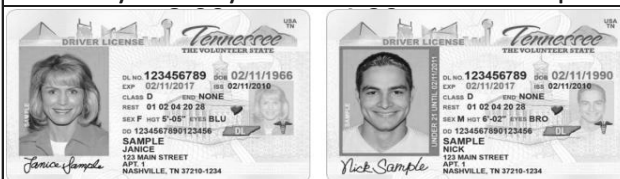
