Registered voters who are unable to vote at their polling place on Election Day may vote by one of the following methods:

1. VOTING EARLY BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE

July 12, 2024 through July 27, 2024, a voter desiring to vote by personal appearance shall go to any location above to cast their ballot. The last day to Early Vote by personal appearance is July 27, 2024. State law requires voters to present a Federal or State of Tennessee Photo ID to vote, unless an exception applies. Voters who do not have proper Photo ID, and an exception does not apply, will be allowed to vote a provisional ballot and will have two (2) business days after Election Day to appear at the Sumner County Election Commission office to present the proper Photo ID and sign an affidavit. Examples of acceptable Photo ID's include: Tennessee Driver License with Photo, United States Passport, Tennessee Department of Safety Photo ID, United States Military Photo ID, or a State of Tennessee issued Handgun Carry Permit with Photo.

2. VOTING BY MAIL

A voter must meet certain legal qualifications to vote by mail. A voter desiring to vote absentee by mail must request an absentee ballot application either in person at the Sumner County Election Commission office, by telephone, by fax, by email or by mail. Such request for an application must be received no later than July 25, 2024. The request can serve as an application for ballot if it contains the following: registered voter's name, address of residence, social security number, voter's date of birth, election date to vote in, address to which the ballot is to be mailed, the reason the voter wishes to vote absentee, and the voter's signature.

The Sumner County Election Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability. If there are questions about needed accommodations in the voting process, call 615-452-1456.
