In 2023, the State of Tennessee passed legislation requiring each of the 95 counties in Tennessee to perform one of three specified audits after each August and November election, beginning with the 2024 election cycle. The type of audit conducted would be determined based on random selection by the Secretary of State, Tre Hargett.

For the August 1, 2024, Election, Sumner County was selected to conduct a “Performance Audit.” That Audit was conducted on November 12, 2024 per State guidelines.

It is with tremendous pride and respect that the Sumner County Election Commission announces that they received a perfect score on the Audit. This is a huge honor, considering this Audit cycle was the first of its type in Sumner County following the implementation of the new legislation.
