

**SUMNER COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES
Friday, August 16, 2024, 9:00 a.m.**

Members present: Chairman M. Allen Ehmling; Secretary Denise D. Shepherd; Commissioners Patricia D. Collins, J. Michael Fussell and Jeffery B. Hulsey. Also present: Lori D. Atchley, Administrator of Elections (AOE) and Annette Haw, Assistant Administrator of Elections (AAOE).

I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Ehmling with a motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Fussell and the motion passed 5 - 0. A quorum was present.

II. APPROVE AGENDA

Commissioner Fussell made a motion to approve the agenda to amend to move Item NEW BUSINESS V. A. and V.B. to follow the REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATOR, as Chairman Ehmling had a prior appointment and might have to leave the meeting before its conclusion, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey and the motion passed 5 - 0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENTS

None.

IV. APPROVE MINUTES

A motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to approve the July 9, 2024, Regular Meeting Minutes and the motion passed 5 - 0.

A motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Fussell to approve the July 19, 2024, Special Call Meeting Minutes and the motion passed 4-0-1 with Commissioner Collins abstaining.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. REPORT FROM ADMINISTRATOR

- FACILITY UPDATE

The Election Commission continues to operate in two locations (1019 Union School Road and 355 N. Belvedere Dr). SCEC has yet to hear a reply from the ad hoc committee formed by the SCC.

- **BUDGET UPDATE**

AOE reported that the SCC budget committee finalized the 2024 - 2025 budget, having removed \$576,000 including raises for office staff from the SCEC approved and submitted budget. Chairman Ehmling to contact Attorney Tom Lee to pen an open letter to the citizens of Sumner County.

- **APPROVE NOVEMBER 5, 2024, POLL WORKERS**

Motion to approve the Republican Poll Workers by Commissioner Hulsey with the caveat that AOE and AAOE can replace poll workers as needed if a vacancy should occur due to resignation, death, illness, etc. in order to properly staff each voting location, seconded by Commissioner Fussell, and the motion passed 3 – 0.

Motion to approve the Democratic Poll Workers by Commissioner Shepherd with the caveat that AOE and AAOE can replace poll workers as needed if a vacancy should occur due to resignation, death, illness, etc. in order to properly staff each voting location, seconded by Commissioner Collins, and the motion passed 2 – 0.

- **APPROVE UPDATED NOVEMBER 5, 2024, ELECTION DAY, EARLY VOTING AND LICENSED FACILITIES LOCATIONS, DATES AND TIMES**

Motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Shepherd to accept the schedules as presented, with the caveat that licensed facility voting dates could be moved if access to a licensed facility was unavailable due to sickness and restriction by the facility director, and the motion passed 5 – 0. Commissioner Hulsey made a motion to affirm that the polls shall be open only during the stated times for early voting and election day. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Collins and the motion passed 4-1, with Commissioner Fussell voting no.

- **CERTIFY AUGUST 1, 2024, ELECTION**

AOE read the results for each office that was present on the ballot, motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins to certify the Republican Primary election, the motion passed 5-0; Motion by Commissioner Collins, seconded by Commissioner Hulsey to certify the Democratic Primary election, and the motion passed 5 – 0; Motion by Commissioner Fussell, seconded by Commissioner Collins to certify the County General, and the motion passed 5 – 0; Motion by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Collins to certify the State and Federal Primary Election and the motion passed 4 – 0. Chairman Ehmling had a prior commitment and had to leave the meeting early. The Commissioners signed the appropriate certification documents for the State Division of Elections.

- **SIGN WALL CERTIFICATES**

Commissioners signed the successful candidate certificates.

B. INSPECTION – APPEAL PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

There were two appeals.

Two voters, ELB and VCV inadvertently marked “Yes” to “Have you been convicted of a felony” question. An appeal form was mailed to each of the voters who completed and signed the appeal form that they had not been convicted of a felony. After the Commissioners present reviewed the documentation, a motion was made by Commissioner Hulsey, seconded by Commissioner Shepherd to accept the voter registration applications to appropriately register the voters to vote. The motion passed 4 – 0.

C. INSPECTION – NEWLY PROCESSED VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS

Commissioners inspected 207 voter registration applications out of 2,065 new registration applications with no discrepancies noted. Commissioners present signed the report to be submitted to the State Division of Elections.

VII. ADJOURNMENT


